Term: 1 year with the option to renew

Responsibilities / Individual

- Attend or be involved in 75% of all YLAC meetings/events (attendance not required for involvement, i.e. skype in, send notes, etc.)
- Contribute a minimum of \$120 annually to Global Links (either via a personal donation, as a monthly sustaining donor or fundraising outside of YLAC group events)
- Serve on at least 1 event committee annually
- Promote an open, supportive, and collaborative environment to achieve groups' goals
- Identify and research new ideas for YLAC to engage with the community and/or further Global Links' mission
