



Donate, don't discard

Help Global Links improve health in communities that lack resources. Your surplus medical supplies, gently-used furnishings, and extra equipment can be donated for reuse instead of sitting in storage or discarded.

Global Links can accept the following items from facilities:

Medical Supplies

- This includes, but is not limited to, items commonly used for surgery, wound & skin care, labor and delivery, lab & blood draw, IV, patient hygiene & health worker protection.

Medical Furnishings

- Including hospital beds, mattresses, exam tables, IV poles, bedside tables, chairs, carts, gurneys, stools, mayo stands, cribs & more.

Office and Administrative Furnishings

- Including filing cabinets, supply cabinets, non-fabric chairs, racking, shelving, tables, desks & more.

Durable Medical Equipment

- Including wheelchairs, crutches, canes, walkers & more.

Biomedical Equipment & Surgical Instruments

- Including microscopes, centrifuges, autoclaves, BP units (non-mercury), oto/ophthalmoscopes, digital thermometers, scales, exam lamps & more.

Liquid Nutrition

-Oral only (ex: Boost, Ensure).

Incontinence Supplies

*All supplies must be unused, unopened, and not expire for at least 13 months.

†All furnishing items must be working, clean, and rust free.
